This year's *Rising Blue Star Camps* will be for players in grades 5-8, with the *Blue Star Combine* focusing on the high school players, grades 9-11. The camps will be held predominantly in September in October, and several of this year's cities are already open for registration. The 4th rendition of the American *Blue Star 30 Camp* was held in Wilmington, Delaware this past June at the beautiful Philadelphia 76ers Fieldhouse.







On top of the All-Star games, some surprise guests and speakers are expected to be in attendance. The *Blue Star Media* team and some of the country's top evaluators including multiple McDonald's All-American voters will be on hand. Video, social media, online, and print coverage of the event will be in abundance. Some of the top club and high school coaches in the country will be coaching the All-Star Teams, and all games will be streamed online.
